#### Description

THE CITY OF SUDBURY WAS FORMED ON JANUARY 1ST, 2001. WITH A GEOGRAPHIC AREA ENCOMPASSING SOME 3,627 SQUARE KILOMETERS, THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY IS THE SECOND LARGEST CITY IN CANADA AND THE LARGEST MUNICIPALITY IN ONTARIO BASED ON LAND MASS. THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY PROVIDES MUNICIPAL SERVICES TO MORE THAN 160,000 CITIZENS WITHIN ITS VAST GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES.
