

BY-LAW 2012-99

**A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY TO
AMEND BY-LAW 2007-250 A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE ERECTION OF SIGNS
AND ADVERTISING DEVICES**

WHEREAS the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to amend By-law 2007-250, as amended, being a By-law to Regulate the Erection of Signs and Advertising Devices;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

Replace Section 31

1-(1) By-law 2007-250, a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Regulate the Erection of Signs and Advertising Devices, as amended, is hereby further amended by repealing Section 31 and enacting the following Section 31 in its place and stead:

"Maximum Term of Permit - Portable Sign

31.(1) The Manager shall not issue a permit authorizing the erection of a portable sign on a property which is in a "Residential" zone, as identified in Subsection 1(2), for a period which is longer than 48 hours.

(2) The Manager shall not issue a permit authorizing the erection of a portable sign on a property which is in a zone other than a "Residential" zone, as identified in Subsection 1(2), for a term other than 1 month, 2 months, 3 months, 4 months, 5 months, 6 months or 12 months.

(3) Every permit authorizing the erection of a portable sign shall expire on the date specified in the permit."

Replace Section 42

2.-(1) By-law 2007-250, a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Regulate the Erection of Signs and Advertising Devices, as amended is hereby further amended by repealing Section 42 and enacting the following Section 42 in its place and stead

"Limitations - Numbers and Frequency of Permits

42.(1) Despite any other provision in this By-law, the Manager shall not issue a permit to erect a portable sign on a property unless the total number of portable signs authorized to be erected on that property at any given point in time will not exceed the number in Column A which corresponds to the Street Length of that property as set out in Column B below:

Column A Maximum Number of Portable Signs authorized to be erected on a Property at any point in time	Column B Length of Street Line for that Property
Maximum of 1 portable sign authorized at any time	Property street length of 137.2 metres or less
Maximum of 2 portable signs authorized at any time	Property street length of more than 137.2 Metres but not more than 243.8 metres
Maximum of 3 portable signs authorized at any time	Property street length of more than 243.8 metres

(2) For the purposes of this By-law a sign designed to be or intended to be a portable sign does not cease to be a portable sign when there is no message on the portable sign."

Enactment

3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on July 1st, 2012
