

BY-LAW 82-62

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 73-31 BEING A
BY-LAW OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF SUDBURY
TO REGULATE THE USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS
AND DRAINS, THE INSTALLATION AND CONNECTION OF
BUILDING SEWERS, THE DISCHARGE OF WATERS AND
WASTES INTO THE SANITARY SEWAGE SYSTEMS OF THE
REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF SUDBURY

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Regional
Municipality of Sudbury deems it desirable to amend By-law 73-31 being a
by-law of the Regional Municipality of Sudbury to regulate the use of
public and private sewers and drains, the installation and connection of
building sewers, the discharge of waters and wastes into the sanitary
sewerage systems of the Regional Municipality of Sudbury;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE REGIONAL
MUNICIPALITY OF SUDBURY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law 73-31 be, and the same is hereby amended by
deleting Section 5.3 thereto, and replacing it with the following:
"5.3 Upon approval of the application, the
applicant shall pay to the Regional Treasurer the
sum of \$3.00, which fee shall entitle the applicant to:
(a) an inspection by the Regional Engineer of the
sewer and the connection to the public sewer
or building sewer at the street line and,
(b) an examination of the sewer joints and grade."
2. This by-law shall come into force and take effect immediately
upon the final passing thereof.
