

Recycling in the Workplace

Municipal Recycling Programs

Biz-Box Program

Join the City of Greater Sudbury's Biz-Box program – designed for small businesses with smaller recycling needs. The program allows your business to place three yellow boxes or one big yellow at the curb weekly. Businesses must purchase the boxes (\$15) or the big yellow (\$30.50). The annual fee for collection is currently only \$59.



Frobisher Street Recycling Depot

Deliver recyclable material to the Frobisher Street Recycling Depot. There is no fee to deliver recyclable material to the City of Greater Sudbury's Recycling Centre (1825 Frobisher St. in Sudbury). The Recycling Centre Depot is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Landfill and Waste Diversion Sites

Each Landfill site is equipped with a recycling area. When you segregate your recycling from your other waste types, there is no tipping fee to dispose of your recyclables in the recycling area.

Private Recycling Options Available Through Various Local Waste Collection and Disposal Companies

If the municipal programs listed above are not suitable for your business' needs, most private waste collection and disposal companies found in the yellow pages will offer the following services.

Recycling Carts

Use recycling carts. The 4-foot blue plastic carts on wheels are ideal for properties where space is limited. Some services will come into the building to empty the carts while others may require that they be placed in a specific location outside on the premise.

Front-end Bins

Have a large recycling bin beside your large garbage bin outside. Users of this system attest that they almost don't need their large garbage bin after all the recycling begins entering the recycling bin. Most private collection services will offer a mixed recycling bin where you can mix your cardboard and other recyclables within one bin.

Janitorial services

Ask your janitorial service. Businesses that have hired janitorial services may find they will collect recyclables. Check what your janitorial service provides and decide what is best for you.
