RIGHTS OF SCRUTINEERS

- ✓ To protect the secrecy of the vote, scrutineers will not be able to examine the ballots; object to the ballots or to the counting of votes in a ballot as provided for in paragraphs 47(5)(e) and 47(5)(f) and subsection 54(3) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, as the ballots are being fed into the vote tabulator by the election official.
- ✓ The total of votes cast for each candidate as counted by the vote tabulating equipment and as accepted by the Equipment Deputy Returning Officer is final.
- ✓ To enter the voting place 15 minutes before it opens and to inspect the ballot boxes and the ballots and all other papers, forms and documents relating to the vote (but not so as to delay the timely opening of the voting place).
- ✓ To place a seal on a ballot box before opening of the voting place.
- ✓ To place a seal on a ballot box at the conclusion of voting on each day of advance voting.
- ✓ To place a seal on the ballot transfer case after the counting of the votes when the Equipment Deputy Returning Officer seals the box.
- ✓ To object to an elector voting (objection to be decided by the election official).
- ✓ To view and sign the statement of the results of voting at the voting station.
