BY-LAW 2011-127

A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY TO AMEND BY-LAW 2003-209 AS AMENDED, A BY-LAW TO ADOPT AN ALCOHOL RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY

WHEREAS Council for the City of Greater Sudbury deems it advisable to amend By-law 2003-209 as amended by By-law 2004-179, being a By-law to adopt an Alcohol Risk Management Policy;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY

HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Replace 5.8.7 of Schedule A

1. By-law 2003-209 as amended by By-law By-law 2004-179, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Adopt an Alcohol-Risk Management Policy is hereby further amended by repealing Subsection 5.8.7 of Schedule A to By-law 2003-209 as repealed and replaced by By-law 2004-179 and enacting the following Subsection 5.8.7 in its place and stead:

"5.8.7 Underage youth shall not be served alcohol. The only acceptable forms of age identification will be:

- (a) a driver's licence issued by the Province of Ontario with a photograph of the person to whom the licence is issued;
- (b) a Canadian passport;
- (c) a Canadian citizenship card with a photograph of the person to whom the card was issued;
- (d) a Canadian Armed Forces identification card;
- (e) a secure certificate of Indian status issued by the Government of Canada;
- (f) a photo card issued by the Liquor Control Board of Ontario;
- (g) a permanent resident card issued by the Government of Canada;

(h) a photo card issued under the *Photo Card Act, 2008.*

Such identification shall be inspected before admitting/serving a person who may be under the age of 19."

Effective Date

2. This By-law comes into effect upon final passage.
