Children's Diaper Waste Container Label

The children's diaper waste container label is a sticker that may be placed on an approved garbage container. Containers bearing this label can be used to contain your clear bags of children's diaper waste only. This label is only available to residents who have applied for, and been approved to participate in the Diaper Waste Exemption program.

An approved container must:

- Have a maximum capacity of 133 L / 35 gal
- Be no taller than 95 cm / 3.1 ft
- Be no wider than 60 cm / 2 ft
- Have handles set above the midpoint on both sides of the container

- Have a lid that can be easily and completely removed
- Weigh less than 18 kg / 40 lbs when full
- Not be a Recycling Container

This container must be dedicated to clear bags of children's diapers only. Other garbage, recycling, organics and/or leaf and yard trimmings must NOT be placed in this container.

Children's diapers must be placed in a clear bag inside the container. Loose diapers will not be collected.

The label must wrap around the container and be clearly visible. Do not place the label lengthwise, or on the lid of the container.
