

**By-law 2018-190**

**A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Amend  
By-law 2014-1 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury  
Governing Procurement Policies and Procedures**

**Whereas** Council of the City of Greater Sudbury deems it desirable to amend By-law 2014-1 being the By-law Governing Procurement Policies and Procedures of the City of Greater Sudbury;

**Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:**

Replace 22.(1)(b)(i)

1. By-law 2014-1 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Governing Procurement Policies and Procedures, as amended, is hereby further amended by repealing subsection 22.(1)(b)(i) and enacting the following subsection in its place and stead:

"(i) the standardization or compatibility of a Purchase with existing equipment, product standards, facilities or service is a paramount consideration;"

Replace 22(2)

2. By-law 2014-1 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Governing Procurement Policies and Procedures, as amended, is hereby further amended by repealing subsection 22(2) and enacting the following subsection in its place and stead:

"(2) Any Non-Competitive Purchase with a Total Acquisition Cost between \$25,000 and \$99,999 must be approved by the Agent prior to any Award by an Authorized Person."

Replace 33.(1)


3. By-law 2014-1 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Governing Procurement Policies and Procedures, as amended, is hereby further amended by repealing subsection 33.(1) and enacting the following subsection in its place and stead:


"(1) The Award of all procurements over \$4,999 shall be formalized by way of a Purchase Order or other Contract issued to confirm the purchase of Goods, Services or Construction."

Effective Date
