A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Amend By-law 2018-29 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Regulating Noise

Whereas Council for the City of Greater Sudbury enacted By-law 2018-29 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Regulating Noise;

Whereas the *Municipal Act, 2001* has been amended to impose certain restrictions on the ability of a municipality to prohibit and regulate with respect to noise;

Whereas Council for the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to amend By-law 2018-29 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Regulating Noise to reflect the said changes;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. By-law 2018-29 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Regulating Noise, is hereby amended by enacting the following section 10A immediately after section 10 and before section 11:
 - **"10.A** Despite any other provision in this By-law, this By-law shall not apply to sounds made in connection with the delivery of goods to any of the following:
 - (a) Retail business establishments;
 - (b) Restaurants, including cafes and bars;
 - (c) Hotels and motels; or
 - (d) Goods distribution facilities.
- **2.** This By-law comes into full force and effect upon passage.
