

**BY-LAW 2013-33**

**A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY  
TO AMEND BY-LAW 2010-188, A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT,  
REGULATE AND CONTROL DISCHARGES INTO BODIES OF WATER  
WITHIN CITY BOUNDARIES OR INTO CITY SANITARY SEWERS,  
STORM SEWERS, SANITARY SEWAGE WORKS AND ALL  
TRIBUTARY SEWER SYSTEMS**

**WHEREAS** Council for the City of Greater Sudbury deems it advisable to amend By-law 2010-188, as amended being a By-law to Prohibit, Regulate and Control Discharges into Bodies of Water Within City Boundaries or into City Sanitary Sewers, Storm Sewers, Sanitary Sewage Works and All Tributary Sewer Systems;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY  
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. By-law 2010-188 as amended, being a By-law Prohibit, Regulate and Control Discharges into Bodies of Water Within City Boundaries or into City Sanitary Sewers, Storm Sewers, Sanitary Sewage Works and All Tributary Sewer Systems is further amended by repealing Subsection 18(1) and enacting the following Subsection 18(1) in its place and stead:


"18.(1)An industry which is discharging an effluent which is not in compliance with limits in Schedule A or Schedule B may apply in writing to the General Manager for approval of a proposed Compliance Program intended to bring the industry into compliance with this By-law within a fixed period of time."

Effective Date

2. This By-law comes into effect upon final passage.
