

By-law 2014-257

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Amend Bylaw 2012-256, A By-law to Adopt a Building, Property and Park Naming Policy

Whereas by By-law 2012-256 the City of Greater Sudbury adopted a Building, Property and Parks Naming Policy;

And Whereas the Police Services Board has requested Council of the City of Greater Sudbury delegate to the Police Services Board the authority to name, in accordance with a policy to be developed and adopted by the Police Services Board, rooms within those City owned facilities which are primarily occupied and used by the Police Services;

And Whereas Council is prepared to authorize such changes to the City's policy;

Now Therefore the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury Hereby Enacts as Follows:

1. Despite anything provided for in By-law 2012-256, a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Adopt a Building, Property and Parks Naming Policy, rooms in City owned buildings which are occupied by the Greater Sudbury Police Services, shall, while occupied by the Greater Sudbury Police Services be exempted from the application of By-law 2012-256.
2. The Greater Sudbury Police Services Board is delegated the authority to name, in accordance with a policy to be adopted by the Greater Sudbury Policy Service Board, rooms in City owned buildings occupied primarily or solely by the Greater Sudbury Police Services. The naming of any such rooms may continue in effect during the term of occupation of the building by the Greater Sudbury Police Services.

3. This By-law comes in full force and effect upon passage.
