

By-law 2014-66

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Amend By-law 2014-3F being a By-law to Establish Miscellaneous User Fees for Certain Services

Whereas the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury deems it desirable to amend By-Law 2014-3 as amended, being a By-Law to Establish Miscellaneous User Fees for Certain Services Provided by the City of Greater Sudbury;

Now therefore the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury Enacts as follows:

Replace Section 2

1. Section 2 of By-law 2014-3, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Establish Miscellaneous User Fees for Certain Services Provided by the City of Greater Sudbury is hereby repealed and the following Section 2 enacted in its place and stead:

“2. (1) Notwithstanding Subsection 1(1) above, the General Manager of Community Development may reduce the amount of, or waive the requirement for the payment of a fee in a Schedule identified in Subsection 1(1), where the General Manager of Community Development is satisfied it would be unreasonable in the circumstances to require payment in accordance with that Schedule.

(2) Notwithstanding Subsection 1(1) above, where a City facility is governed by a Joint Use Agreement with a School Board which establishes fees or provides for a fee waiver for the use of that City facility, the fee shall be governed by the Joint Use Agreement and not this By-law.

(3) Notwithstanding Subsection 1(1) fees and charges identified in Schedule CD-D shall be due and payable 60 days after signing the agreement for the purchase giving rise to the fees and charges, unless earlier payment is required pursuant to the *Funeral, Burial and Cremation Act, 2002*, S.O. 2002, c. 33.

(4) Fees and Charges provided for in Schedule "CD-N" – Special Family Day shall be in effect on Family Day, despite the fee or charge provided for in any other Schedule.

3. By-law 2014-3F is hereby amended by repealing Schedule "CD-I" and enacting Schedule "CD-I", attached hereto as Schedule A and forming part of this By-law, in its place and stead.

4. By-law 2014-4F is hereby further amended by repealing Schedule "G&D-A" and enacting Schedule "G&D-A", attached hereto as Schedule B and forming part of this By-law, in its place and stead.

5. This By-law shall come into force and effect upon passage.

Notes:

1. Non-profit groups have permission to book periodic meetings at no cost and are responsible for the cleaning for the facility immediately after the meeting, to an acceptable level as outlined in the facility rental agreement. Leisure staff has the responsibility to manage the schedule for free meetings in order to meet the needs of all nonprofit groups equitably.

Non profit is defined as a "recognized non-profit organization".

Meeting is defined as "a gathering for the purpose of the organizations business" i.e. Annual General Meetings, monthly executive meetings, with the intention of a lecture style set up to include light refreshments only. Meetings are not intended for fundraising events, elaborate gatherings, or large scale leisure activities.

2. Non-profit groups are entitled one free rental per year for an event that is outside of the definition of a meeting, as explained above. For example, fundraisers, dinners, dances, holiday events, large scale events related to tournaments or other leisure activities. The free rental does not include ancillary costs such as insurance or any additional amenities other than what is available on site at the facility. Subsequent to the annual "free rental usage", the nonprofit group would be subject to fees as outlined in the user fee by-law.

3. For the purposes of meetings only, any non-profit group can use any CGS leisure meeting room or hall at no cost.
