May 25, 2021

Arena/Event Centre

- Event Centre Updated Information Report is on track for June 16 meeting
- Ron Bidulka and PwC leading the work
 - Conrad Boychuk, Architect is assisting
 - Connecting with industry leaders and other event centres across North America
 - Both will be present on June 16 to present findings and answer questions
- Cost of Event Centre project to date is \$2,700,671. or 2.7% of project budget

May 25, 2021

Place des Arts

- Construction continues with focus on the interior of the building
- Concrete is now poured and work is underway on the bistro space on the first floor
- Staff continue to meet regularly with PdA and downtown stakeholders to ensure open communication and to mitigate impacts where possible
- \$3 million of \$5 million has been paid by CGS
 - Next instalment of \$1.5 million triggered by substantial completion of building, expected in next few months

Junction West

- Staff will meet with CBRE in late June to discuss hotel investment process and timing for RFEOI
- KED Update Report will provide insight on future of hospitality industry and impact of COVID-19
- Junction West project expenses to date are \$712,041.

Junction East Engagement

- Community Engagement Campaign concluded in April
 - Over 330 surveys completed
 - Comments received on display boards in public library branches
 - 4 virtual public open houses/brainstorming sessions
 - Over 20 focus groups on topics such as sustainability, accessibility, families and children, seniors and more.
 - Targeted outreach to specific audiences such as Urban Indigenous, Metis and First Nations, 2SLGBTQ+, Black, People of Colour and Newcomers, social service providers, families and children, seniors and more.

Max Parking Lot

- City has acquired former residential lot property on Shaughnessy Street
- Boris Max operated a parking lot on the property for many years during his retirement until his death in late 2020
 - Boris was a familiar figure as he personally tended the lot and interacted with parkers
- Small but important piece of land for this project
- Max Family was extremely helpful in ensuring transfer completed quickly
