ORDER

UPON INFORMAL MOTION considered at the outset of the trial of these proceedings,

THIS COURT ORDERS that:

1. No person who is intended to be a non-expert witness at the trial of these proceedings shall, prior to such person having testified as a witness, be present in Court during the testimony of another witness for the party (expert or non-expert) in the trial of these proceedings.
2. No person shall communicate the substance of the evidence given by a witness for a party (expert or non-expert) during the trial of these proceedings to a second person who is intended to be a non-expert witness for that party at the trial of these proceedings, prior to that second person having testified as a witness at the trial of these proceedings during the party's case in chief.
3. For the purpose of this Order, all of the Plaintiffs shall be treated as a single party.
4. There shall be no costs of this Order.
