Instruction to Clerk of the Court pursuant to s. 49(5)(b) of the *Provincial Offences Act* – to adjourn all matters scheduled on March 16 , 2026:

I am instructing you pursuant to s. 49(5)(b) of the *Provincial Offences Act* to adjourn all matters scheduled in your court at **239 Montee Principale, Azilda** on March 16, 2026. This instruction applies to all matters scheduled on that date. You are directed to reschedule matters as follows:

- (a) All Part I and Part II matters are to be rescheduled administratively with written notice to defendants and prosecution by way of new Notices of Trial.
- (b) All Part III matters are to be adjourned to **April 20, 2026 at 9:30 a.m., 239 Montee Principale, www.zoom.us, Meeting ID: 922 6095 5707, Passcode: 566388**
- (c) Defendants and prosecution are to be advised in writing. At the next court appearance, trial and resolutions dates will be set and confirmed.

A notice of this court closure and details on the rescheduling process, including how to obtain information about a next court date, are to be posted on the website of Provincial Offences Office.

Where possible, a notice of the court closure is to be posted at the court location and the recorded greeting on the Provincial Offences Office's voice mail should include a message advising of the court closure.

For greater certainty, each adjournment need not be addressed on the record, but court documents should note the court closure and adjournment.
