## What's The G.I.S.?

To qualify for the Elderly Property Tax Assistance Credit, the applicant or spouse must be receiving the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) Under Part II of the Old Age Security Act (Canada).

The Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) is an income tested, monthly benefit for seniors with limited incomes. It is a benefit that low income seniors receive in addition to their Old Age Security pension.

## Who Qualifies?

To qualify for the City of Greater Sudbury's Elderly Tax Credit, you or your spouse must:

- be receiving the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) from the Federal Government
- 2. be a City of Greater Sudbury resident
- 3. be at least 65 years old, as of December 31, 2024
- be assessed as the owner of residential property for the entire current year
- occupy a single family dwelling unit in the City of Greater Sudbury on which municipal taxes have been levied.

Note: If your spouse is deceased you may continue to qualify for the credit if certain criteria are met. Please contact 3-1-1 for details. This year and every year following, you must complete and then send in the Elderly Tax Credit application form which will be mailed to you. If you do not receive the form, it will be up to you to contact 3-1-1 and ask that one be sent to you. It will also be your responsibility to mail it back to the Tax Department each year. (Your application must be received by December 31st of each year in order to receive the credit).
