

**BACKGROUND:**

See attached report dated August 3, 2005 from the General Manager of Infrastructure & Emergency Services regarding award of Contract 2005-21, MR 80 (Highway 69 North), Upgrading Valleyview Road to Main Street.



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

Division Review

Background:

This project involves the widening and rehabilitation of MR 80 from Valleyview Road to Main Street in Val Caron. It includes the construction of new water mains, storm sewers and sidewalks. This is the first project to be tendered as part of the City's COMRIF program.

Tenders were opened at the Tender Opening Committee Meeting at 2:30 p.m., on Tuesday July 19<sup>th</sup>, 2005, and the following are the results:

K.J. Beamish Construction Limited	\$4,384,326.93
Pioneer Construction Inc.	\$4,497,976.26
R. M. Belanger Limited	\$4,550,351.55
Teranorth Construction and Engineering Limited	\$4,549,955.33
Interpaving Limited	\$4,744,380.00
Garson Pipe Contractor Limited	\$4,626,823.12

The tenders were reviewed and the lowest tender submitted by K.J. Beamish, was missing a page from the Form of Tender and found to be incomplete. In accordance with the City's Purchasing By-law, the tender must be rejected.

The next lowest tender is that of Pioneer Construction Inc. in the amount of \$4,497,976.26 and it was found to be in order.

This project is a part of the City's COMRIF program and the actual construction will take two years to complete and is expected to be finished in the summer of 2006.

The project includes road work in the amount of \$3,755,000 excluding GST. The City's share of the road work is \$1,327,000 including the utility relocations. Funding will be provided from the 2005 Capital Roads Budget in the amount of \$900,000 and an additional \$427,000 to be committed from the 2006 Capital Roads Envelope.

The tender also includes sewer and water main improvements in the amount of \$450,000, which is included in the 2005 Capital Water Projects
