to facilitate the 4th Annual West End Weekend Community Festival.

Executive Summary:

This is the 4th Annual West End Weekend sponsored by the Nickel City Hotel. The event includes a street dance, casino, live bands and a beer tent. Fundraising will be for a local community charity.

Staff recommends that a temporary street closure of Alder Street be approved for this annual community event.

Background:

Attached is a letter, Exhibit '1', and Application for Approval of Outdoor Fund Raising and Community Festival, Exhibit '2', from Mr. Marty Martel, Manager of the Nickel City Hotel dated May 1st, 2001 requesting Council approval for the temporary closure of a portion of Alder Street in conjunction with their 4th Annual West End Weekend.

The proposed street closure is shown on Exhibit '3' attached.

As in previous years the event will include a street dance, casino, live bands and beer tent. Fundraising will be for a local charity.

The Clerks Department has prepared a concurrent report dealing with the application for an extended liquor license.

Ward Councillor, Gerry McIntaggart supports this application and temporary road closure.

As in previous years, Mr. Martel will be permitted to borrow City barricades and appropriate street signage. City staff will monitor the area to ensure that signage and barricades are properly installed and maintained.

Staff recommend that Council pass the By-law approving the temporary closure of Alder Street between Hazel Street and Willow Street for the following time periods;



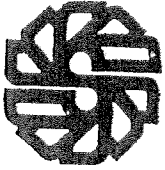

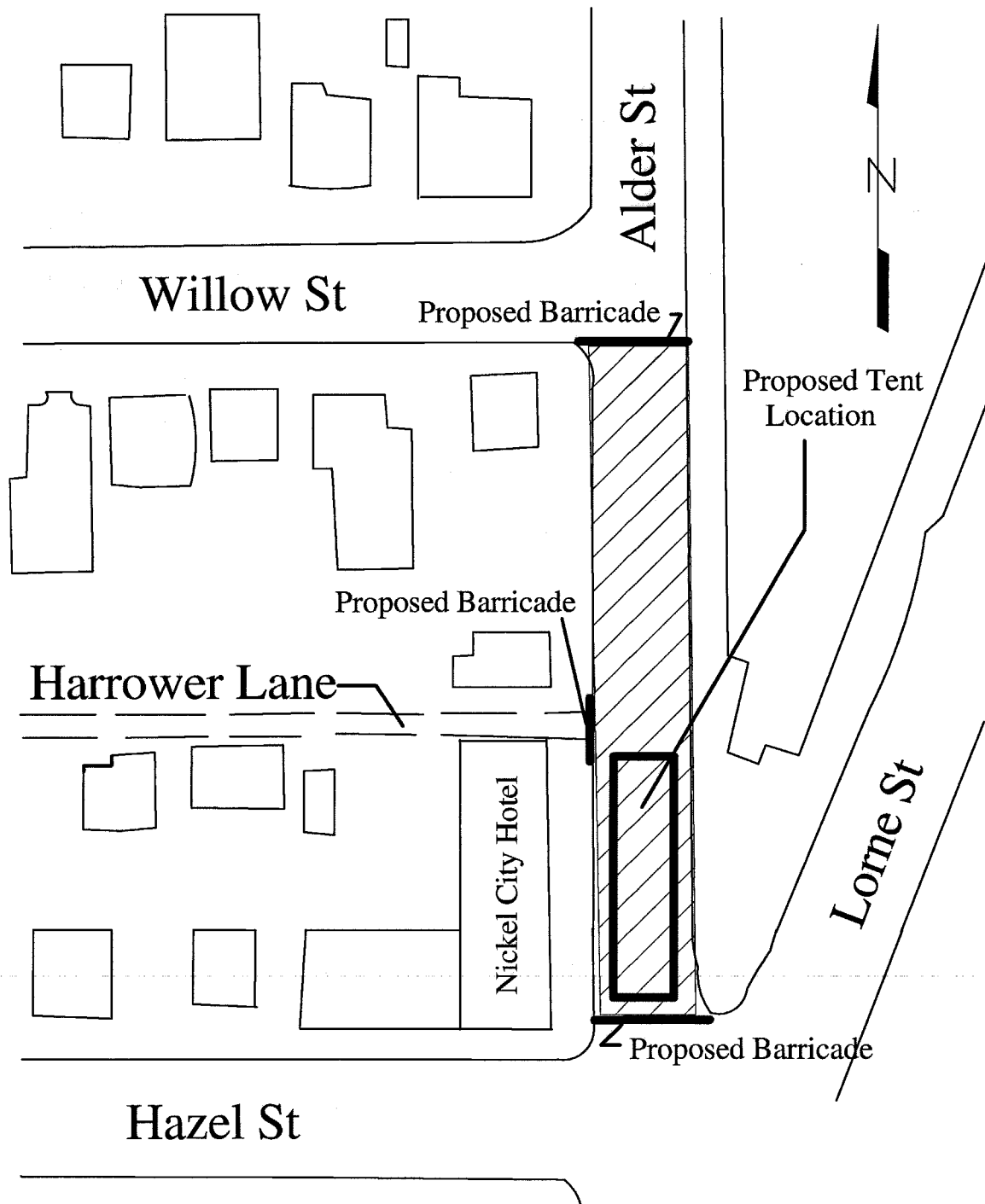

Executive Summary:

As part of the annual Chelmsford Western Days event, "bed races" are organized adjacent to the Algoma Tavern. The bed races follow a course along Errington St., Lorne St., O'Conner St. and Young St. and finish at the Tavern.

Staff recommends that a temporary street closure of these streets be approved for this annual community event.

Background:

Attached is a letter, Exhibit '1', and Application for Approval of Outdoor Fund Raisers and Community Festivals, Exhibit '2', from Mr. Evan Vachon, owner/operator of the Algoma Tavern. Mr. Vachon is requesting the temporary road closure of parts of Errington St., Lorne St., O'Conner St., and Young St. as shown on Exhibit 3 between 2:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 9th, 2001 and Sunday, June 10th, 2001.

As indicated in Mr. Vachon's letter, they are proposing to host the Annual "Bed Races" from his establishment. The participants will race a loop course along Errington St., Lorne St., O'Conner St. and Young St. During the races they will have security personnel at all intersections and along the course to direct traffic and to ensure emergency vehicles are not impeded.

The Clerks Department has prepared a concurrent report dealing with the application for an extended liquor license.

Ward Councillor, Ron Bradley supports this application and temporary road closure.

As in previous years, Mr. Vachon will be permitted to borrow City barricades. City staff will monitor the area to ensure that the barricades are properly installed and maintained.

Staff recommend that Council pass the By-law approving the temporary closure of Errington St., Lorne St., O'Conner St. and Young St. as shown on Exhibit 3 attached for the following time periods;

2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturday, June 9th, 2001
and
2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Sunday, June 10th, 2001

to facilitate the annual Bed Races as part of the Chelmsford Western Days Community Event.

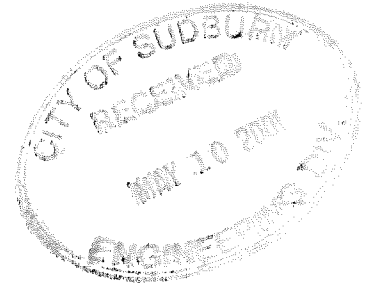

Please keep in mind that these are tentative times. The start time is accurate but the races may end before the 6:00 p.m. deadline.

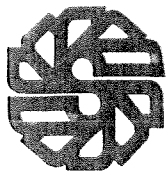

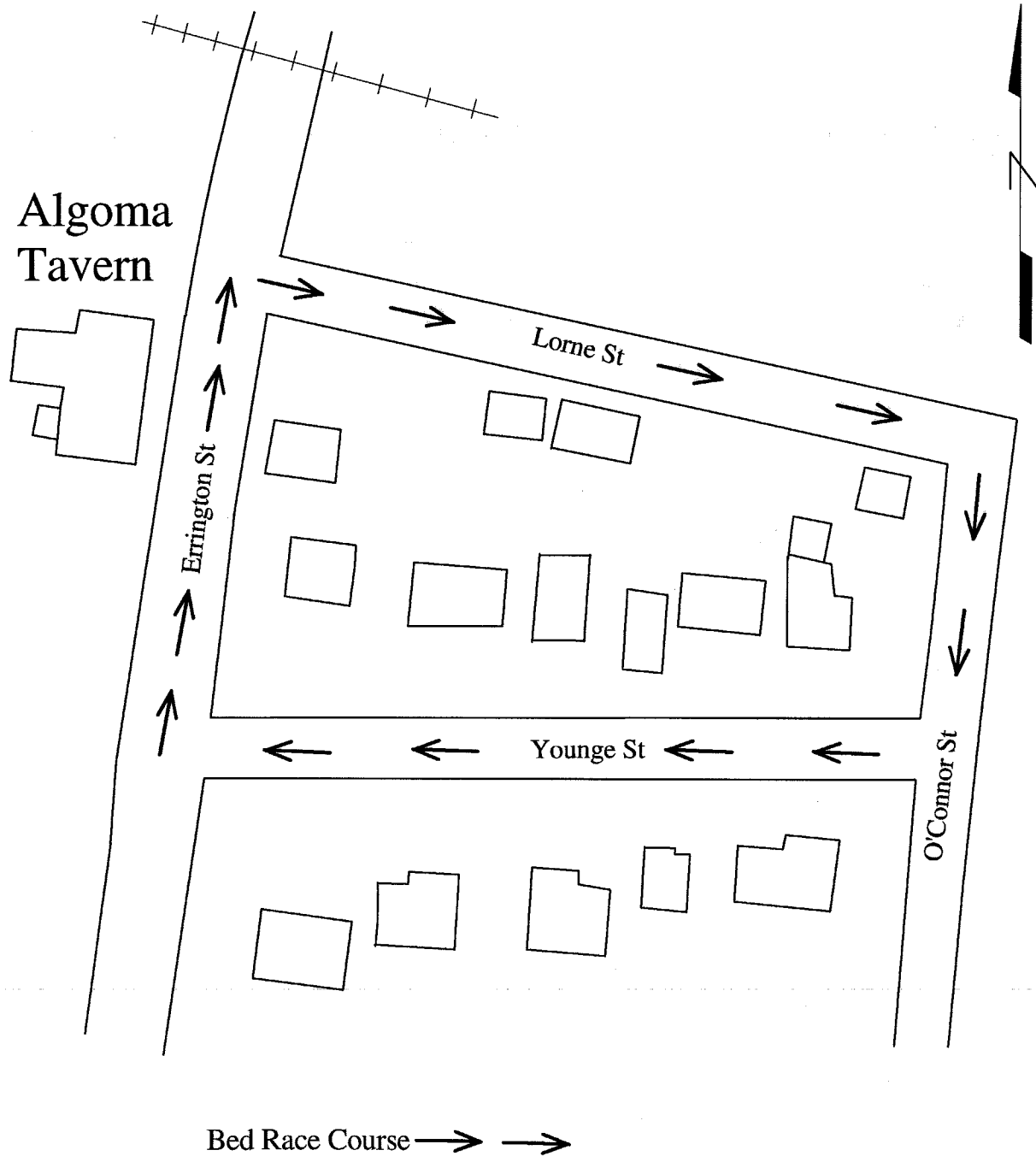
