By-Law 2014-258

A By-Law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Repeal By-Law 2004-204 and to Repeal By-Law 2007-143 as Amended by By-Law 2008-178

WHEREAS by By-law 2004-204, being a by-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Require the Closing of Certain Retail Business Establishments, Council for the City of Greater Sudbury established certain store closing hours;

AND WHEREAS by By-law 2007-143 as amended by By-law 2008-178, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Require Certain Retail Business Establishments to be Closed on the August Civic Holiday and on Boxing Day, Council for the City of Greater Sudbury regulated certain store closings on the specified dates;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with By-law 2012-242 as amended by By-law 2013-93, certain questions were submitted to the electorate in the 2014 municipal election, pertaining to By-laws 2007-143 as amended and 2004-204;

AND WHEREAS Council for the City of Greater Sudbury has determined it is in order to repeal the said By-law 2004-204 and amending By-law 2008-178;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. By-law 2004-204, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Require the Closing of Certain Retail Business Establishments is hereby repealed.

2. By-law 2007-143, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Require Certain Retail Business Establishments to be Closed on the August Civic Holiday and on Boxing Day, and all amending bylaws, including By-law 2008-178 are hereby repealed. 3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon passage.
