

BY-LAW 2012-65

**A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY
TO AMEND BY-LAW 2011-100 A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE SALE
AND DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS IN THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY**

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to amend By-law 2011-100 being a By-law to Regulate the Sale and Discharge of Fireworks in the City of Greater Sudbury;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY
HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**


1. By-law 2011-100 being a By-law to Regulate the Sale and Discharge of Fireworks in the City of Greater Sudbury is amended by repealing the definition of “permitted days” in Section 1 and enacting the following definition in its place and stead:

“permitted days” means:


- (a) Victoria Day;
- (b) Canada Day;
- (c) December 31st;
- (d) January 1st;
- (e) Family Day; or
- (f) a day authorized in writing by the Fire Chief.”

2. By-law 2012-34 is hereby repealed.
3. This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.
