Location / Construction	C	Operated and maintained in a sanitary condition. Maintained in a neat and orderly condition, free of refuse,

Floors and Drains	C	Floors are soundly constructed of hard durable impervious material, sanitizable (no wood), in a good state of repair i.e. no cracks, holes and damage, and sloped to drain. Floor drains and trenches shall not accumulate waste or gases. Drains function properly and are not harboring vermin. Pipes, drains, conduit, or other services are sealed where go through floor.	
Walls	C	Soundly constructed of hard durable material, impervious to water at a height adequate for sanitary maintenance, sanitizable (no wood that animals can reach), in a good state of repair i.e. no cracks, holes and damage. Sealed seams. Pipes, drains, conduit, or other services are sealed where go through wall.	
Doors and Windows	C	In a good state of repair i.e. no cracks, holes and damage. Frames and moldings are tight fitting with no spaces capable of harboring vermin. Window does not allow vermin to enter and coverings are provided to prevent effects of direct sunlight.	
Ceilings / Roofs	C	Soundly constructed, in a good state of repair i.e. no cracks, holes or damage. Pipes, drains, conduit, or other services are sealed where go through ceiling. Must support sanitary conditions.	
Aisles	C	Wide enough for the safe movement of persons and equipment. Do not store or accumulate materials in the aisles.	
<b>ANIMAL HOUSING CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE</b>			
Cages / Kennels Housing	C	Dry surfaces and every animal can comfortably stand, turn around, stretch and lie down fully extended at all times. Readily sanitizable, minimizes pathogen transfer and prevent escapes. If duration in the cage is greater than 21 days, additional requirements must be met. Cats must be supplied with litter and a pan to collect waste.	
Communal Housing	C	No animal shall be placed in communal cages, pens or dog runs if harm is likely to result to any of the animals. Remove the animal causing the harm. Communal cat cages or rooms must have resting perches at different heights.	
Outdoor	C	Change in environment from indoors to outdoors will not

Enclosures		likely result in harm to the dog. Outdoor runs must rapidly drain excess surface water and prevent escapes. Every dog shall have access to shelter large enough to fit all dogs, protects from direct sunlight, precipitation, wind and is dry and well drained.	
<b>SANITATION / CLEANLINESS</b>			
Cages / Kennels	C	Clean surface for animals. Litter or bedding material is changed as necessary to keep it dry, clean and free of noxious fumes. Waste is removed and sanitized (including associated racking) as necessary for animal's health and comfort. Animals are protected from overspray during the cleaning. Previously occupied cages/kennels are sanitized before occupied by another animal.	
Watering and feeding equipment	C	All water and feed equipment will be maintained in a sanitary condition and working order.	We discussed lockable cat bowls. I will send pictures.
Rooms	C	Maintain every room, i.e. housing, food prep., in a clean condition, free of refuse and debris.	
Outdoor enclosures	C	Outdoor dog runs are kept in a clean condition free from any materials or equipment likely to cause harm to a dog.	
Waste disposal	C	Waste materials and excreta are collected and disposed of in a sanitary manner.	
Carcass Disposal	C	Remove dead animals from cage/kennel upon the discovery. Carcasses shall be disposed of by: burying under at least 2 feet of earth, incinerated or taken to a licensed disposal facility.	
<b>ENVIRONMENT</b>			
Lighting	C	Every animal room shall have adequate, evenly distributed lighting for proper observation of all animals with as little glare as possible. All animal rooms shall have adequate lighting for a continuous period or at least 8 hours in every 24 hour period.	
Ventilation	C	Every animal room shall at all times be adequately ventilated, so that clean, fresh air is available, for the health, welfare and comfort of every animal and no condensation is present.	
Temperature	C	Every animal room shall at all times be maintained at a temperature suitable for the health, welfare and comfort of every animal.	

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<b>ANIMAL CARE</b>			
Competent Personnel	C	Pound operator has an adequate number of competent staff to properly care for all animals. Only competent persons shall handle animals.	Met with staff members to view records.
Food/Water	C	Animals must receive adequate amounts of potable water, nutritionally adequate food that is palatable and free from contamination. Food and water containers do not interfere with housing requirements. Food shall not be placed directly on the floor of the cage/kennel. If supplied with perishable food, the remnants of the food shall be removed from the cage/kennel every day.	
Disease Prevention / Control	C	Take all steps practicable to treat and prevent the spread of any disease found in an animal and to prevent distress to any animal.	
Euthanasia	C	Euthanasia must be carried out in an appropriate method by persons properly trained in the euthanasia procedures, occur without unnecessary pain, delay or discomfort and not endanger or disturb other animals.	
Signage / Hours of Operation	C	Pound hours and days on which the pound is open are conspicuously posted outside. Pound shall be open at least once every day while there is an animal present. Pound may be closed one day a week and on statutory holidays but these days will not be counted against the redemption period.	
Redemption Period and Disposition	C	The pound operator is compliant with all the requirements of the Act related to the redemption period, allowable actions following the redemption period, destruction, sale price and all requirements involving pit bulls.	
Pest / Rodent Control	C	All reasonable steps are taken to prevent the spread of and to destroy vermin and invertebrates that may be harmful to the health, comfort or welfare of the animals.	
<b>RECORDS</b>			
Animal Intake and Identification	C	Intake records contain all requirements and are retained at the pound for at least 2 years from the date the animal was last at the pound. Every animal shall be identified by a neckband, individual tag, or cage/kennel card or marking on the cage in which the animal is kept.

Euthanasia Records	C	Records contain the date of euthanasia and a statement setting out the clause of subsection 20 (7) of the Act under which the animal was destroyed (the reason for destruction).
