Terms and Conditions of Adoption

- 1. I agree to treat the animal I am adopting humanely. I will educate myself with respect to my responsibilities towards the pet that I am adopting. I agree to comply with the City of Greater Sudbury Animal Care and Control By-Law 2017-22.
- 2. I agree that I shall provide appropriate care, adequate food, water, shelter and attention to meet the needs of my new pet.
- 3. I understand that the City of Greater Sudbury is not responsible for the nature or condition of the animal that I am adopting after it leaves the City's care. I further understand that due to the numerous animals housed at the Greater Sudbury Animal Shelter, that animals for adoption may have been exposed to transmissible diseases or parasites. This may include respiratory infections, internal parasites, fleas and/or ear mites. The symptoms to watch for are:
 - ♦ Coughing
- Diarrhea
- ◆ Sneezing
 ◆ Sneezing
 ◆ Vomiting
- Discharge from eyes, nose or mouth

- Lethargy/Depression
 - ♦ Fever
- 4. I understand that the City of Greater Sudbury does not have a full time veterinarian on staff and that animals may have only received veterinary care if required. Although every precaution is taken to ensure that they are in good health, I understand that the animal I am adopting may be in need of additional medical attention. As the new owner, any costs incurred will be my responsibility. I agree, the City of Greater Sudbury will not be responsible for reimbursing any costs incurred by me for veterinary treatment.
- 5. I understand that I am responsible for taking the animal I have adopted from the City of Greater Sudbury to a veterinarian when the need arises. If when examined by a veterinarian, the animal is found to have a serious medical condition, I may return it to the Greater Sudbury Animal Shelter for a refund within 2 weeks of adoption, or choose to treat it at my own expense.
- 6. I agree to arrange all necessary vaccinations (if necessary) with a veterinarian for the animal I am adopting.
- 7. I agree that by adopting this animal from the City of Greater Sudbury that I am now fully responsible for ownership of this animal.
