Program Details

We place cats or kittens that are best suited to be barn cats and working cats, not cats that would make house pets. We highly recommend a minimum of two cats be placed at the same location at the same time. A staff member or volunteer may visit the location to ensure it is appropriate for barn cats. In some cases pictures of the barn/shop will be requested instead. Prior to adoption, the cats will be spayed/neutered, dewormed and vaccinated for Feline Rhinotracheitis Virus, Calicivirus, and Panleukopenia (FVRCP).

Due to the nature of the program, we may not have suitable cats available immediately, but will try to fill your request as soon as possible. We will maintain a waiting list as the number of cats available as candidates for the Barn Cat Program will fluctuate.

Program Requirements

A secure, dry barn or building for shelter with heat source is required.

The commitment and ability to keep the cats confined to a stall, small room, or crate for 2-4 weeks (depends on the cats and the barn) to acclimate them to their new environment before release.

A constant supply of dry food and fresh water.

The willingness to trap the cats to provide licensed veterinary care in the event of a severe injury or illness.
