

By-law 2017-40

**A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Amend By-law 2017-22
being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Regulate the Keeping
of Animals, Responsible Pet Ownership and the Registration of Dogs and Cats**

Whereas Council for the City of Greater Sudbury deems it advisable to amend By-law 2017-22 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Regulate the Keeping of Animals, Responsible Pet Ownership and the Registration of Dogs and Cats;

Now therefore the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. By-law 2017-22 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Regulate the Keeping of Animals, Responsible Pet Ownership and the Registration of Dogs and Cats is hereby amended by:
 - (a) repealing subsection 8(1)(b); and
 - (b) repealing paragraph 10(a).
2. By-law 2017-22 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Regulate the Keeping of Animals, Responsible Pet Ownership and the Registration of Dogs and Cats is hereby further amended by repealing section 40 and enacting the following section 40 in its place and stead:

"Failure to Redeem"

40. After the expiration of the Redemption Period, the Pound Keeper may:
 - (a) release the impounded Dog or Cat to its Owner in accordance with section 39; or
 - (b) keep, sell or dispose of, including euthanizing the Dog or Cat subject to the applicable provisions of the *Animals for Research Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. A.22, as amended or replaced from time to time."
3. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon its passage.
