Greater Sudbury Shelter staff will make every reasonable effort to reunite dogs and cats with their owners. Dogs and cats are held at the Shelter for three days, not including the day they are brought in and holidays, before being assessed for adoption.

To claim your dog or cat from the Greater Sudbury Animal Shelter

- Show government identification with your current address
- Pay impound, boarding, licensing and any other fees as applicable
- Have a leash or carrier to take your pet home

Pet owners retrieving their dog or cat from the Shelter must pay:

- Impound Fee: \$61
- Boarding Fee: \$32 per day
- Cost of Veterinary Care: When applicable

If a pet is not licensed, pet owners must also purchase a dog or cat license.

One year, three year and lifetime dog or cat license:

One year license is \$30 for a spayed or neutered pet

One year license is \$46 for an unaltered pet

Three year license is \$71 for a spayed or neutered pet

Three year license is \$117 for an unaltered pet

Lifetime license is \$177 for a spayed or neutered pet

Lifetime license is \$280 for an unaltered pet

Discounts for citizens age 65 and over:

One year license is \$25 for a spayed or neutered pet

One year license is \$35 for an unaltered pet

Three year license is \$61 for a spayed or neutered pet

Three year license is \$94 for an unaltered pet

Lifetime license is \$117 for a spayed or neutered pet

Lifetime license is \$230 for an unaltered pet
