



### 2022 Accomplishments

- Assisted ten community housing providers through Year 4 Canada Ontario Community Housing Initiative (COCHI) for capital repairs. The Urban Native Housing program received COCHI rent supplement funding to offset federal mortgage expiration.
- Received funding through the Year 4 Ontario Priorities Housing Initiative (OPHI) in the amount of \$1,016,400 toward Lorraine Street affordable housing build. The tender was issued and construction started in 2022.
