- Assisted with evacuation of 128 residents
- Temporary lodging at CLELC

Caron Street Natural Gas Leak (February 8, 2012)

- Natural Gas meter damaged
- 6-unit apartment building and 2 homes affected
- Red Cross activated
- Residents sheltered at Quality Inn
- Debrief with all responding services held
