After years of fighting development on the Bennett Lake watershed, FOBL in partnership with Lo-Ellen Park Residents Association reached a settlement to allow development on Fairlane Dr. while protecting the Bennett Lake watershed.

With the agreement, a new trail was cut on the northeast end of the lake to provide a continuous trail around the lake without need to access the Laurentian Nordic trails. This trail will serve a rugged nature trail in the summer and a snowshoe trail in the winter with spectacular views from vantage points around the lake.

Thanks to a grant from the city and generous donations, boardwalks have been installed and clover planted to reduce erosion and silt entering the lake.
