



Approved Garbage Containers

When purchasing or using a garbage container, please ensure that all the following specifications are met:

1. Firstly, the container capacity is **not** more than 133 litres / 35 gallons.
2. The container shall **not** be taller than 95 centimetres / 3.1 feet.
3. The container shall **not** be wider than 60 centimetres / 2 feet.
4. The container will have handles which are set above the midpoint on both sides of the container.
5. The container will have a lid that may be easily and completely removed.
 - Hinged lids are not permitted.
 - Any device used to tie down the lid must be completely removed prior to collection (i.e. bungee cords, ropes, bear bars, fasteners or locks).
6. The container will **not** weigh more than 18 kg / 40 lbs. when filled.
7. All garbage inside the container must be placed in a securely tied bag.

Residents that purchase or use non-approved residential garbage containers may use the container, provided that their household garbage is bagged in **approved garbage bags**. Up to two approved garbage bags will then be collected.
