

Adoption Programs

Citizens are invited to make a personal contribution to a cleaner and greener community through these Clean Up Greater Sudbury Adoption Programs



Who can participate

Everyone is welcome to participate: individuals, volunteer groups, associations, service clubs, businesses, government offices, schools. For safety reasons, one adult (19 and over) must accompany every five children under the age of 12. You may also sponsor a non-profit group to pick up litter on your behalf.

How to participate

Adopt-a-Road

Pick up and remove litter from a two kilometre section of roadway, once during the spring and once during the fall, or more often if you wish.

Adopt-a-Spot

Pick up and remove litter from public land, such as a walkway, trail or near a waterway once during the spring and once during the fall, or more often if you wish.

Adopt-a-Bin

Remove excess garbage from a public litter bin and keep the surrounding area litter free, between regularly scheduled waste collection days.



Your reward

Keeping a part of your community litter free is satisfying in itself. But you'll also receive public recognition for your efforts.

Adopt-a-Road

The City of Greater Sudbury will erect a sign displaying your group or business name as close as possible to your two kilometre section.

Adopt-a-Spot

The City of Greater Sudbury will erect a sign displaying your group or business name, provided it is appropriate and approved for the public area.

Adopt-a-Bin

The City of Greater Sudbury will post a sign displaying your group or business name near the public litter bin.

How to apply for a program

Choose an adoption program and submit an application form to the City of Greater Sudbury. Staff will work with you to identify a section of roadway, public land or litter bin for adoption. If your first choice for adoption is unavailable or unsuitable, staff will help you choose an alternate. Once a location has been finalized, you will receive a formal agreement for signature.
