# Shelter Stays - March 2026



The entire shelter system was at capacity two times in March.

## Encampments

As of March 31, 2026 there were 92 individuals sleeping in encampments across 21 locations. Encampment numbers include individuals who have not consented to be part of the HIFIS database.

## Definitions

**Chronic Homelessness:** Client has been homeless for at least 180 days at some point over the course of a year (not necessarily consecutive days); and/or they have recurrent episodes of homelessness over three years that total at least 18 months.

**Identified as Indigenous:** Client has an Indigenous identity of First Nations: off-reserve, First Nations: on-reserve; Inuit; Métis or non-status as recorded in the Indigenous Status drop-down menu in HIFIS.

**Unsheltered homelessness:** People experiencing homelessness who are staying in unsheltered locations or places not intended for human habitation (e.g., streets, alleys, parks, transit stations, abandoned buildings, vehicles, ravines and other outdoor locations).

**Veterans:** Former members of the Canadian Armed Forces or the Royal Canadian Mounted Police
