Resident Relocation Notice – Courtyard Residents (Killarney, Lilac/Mallard, York/Ramsey, Ramsey/Scenic)

As part of the ongoing redevelopment of Pioneer Manor, we will be reassigning residents currently residing in the Courtyard (Killarney, Lilac/Mallard, York/Ramsey, Ramsey/Scenic) to new Home Areas.

From October 1 through December 31, 2025, coordinators of Intake and Resident Relations will begin contacting residents, substitute decision makers (SDMs) or powers of attorney (POA) to:

- Provide the approximate date of your loved one's relocation
- Share the specific floor and room they will be moving to (location can be shared only on a floor plan at this time)
- Discuss any financial implications and amendments to the admission agreement

Note: The amendment to the agreement will outline the terms for residents who are temporarily relocated from basic to private accommodations as a result of the redevelopment project.

During this temporary relocation, residents will continue to pay the basic accommodation rate. Once a basic accommodation bed becomes available, the resident will be required to transfer back to a basic accommodations room. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during this transition.

Vaccination Clinics (Staff, Families and Visitors)

Influenza, RSV and COVID-19 vaccines will be available at Pioneer Manor. Clinics for residents, staff and visitors will follow the schedule below and operate on a first-come, first-served basis.
