### Grief Support Drop-In Day

Pioneer Manor will be hosting a special grief support drop-in day in Winter Park on Tuesday, February 3, 2026, from 1 to 6:30 p.m. The space will be transformed into a reflection room, originally created by the Saint Elizabeth Foundation, designed to gently support conversations and reflection around grief, loss, death and dying.

Residents are welcome to visit at any time throughout the day to:

- Reflect on their grief in a calm, supportive environment
- Learn coping strategies
- Connect with other residents who may be experiencing similar feelings
- Speak with the pastor or the social worker
- Write a letter or note (with assistance if needed) to share their story or simply take quiet time to pause and reflect

This space is available to all residents who feel they may benefit from comfort, community or a moment of reflection.
