Pet Visits

All pet visits are welcome, as they bring comfort and joy to residents. To keep visits safe and positive, please follow these guidelines:

- Pets must stay under the owner's control and be leashed, held or contained.
- Only healthy, vaccinated animals may visit.
- Pets should arrive clean and well-groomed.
- Confirm the resident is comfortable with animals; pets should not approach others uninvited.
- Pets must remain calm and non-disruptive; remove them if they become agitated.
- Owners must clean up after their pets indoors and outdoors.
- Please avoid pet-restricted areas such as dining rooms, kitchens, the Bistro and leisure rooms when food is present.
