Re: COVID-19 Update #6

As you may be aware, the three (3) residents who tested positive for COVID-19 were re-tested on April 30, 2020. We are pleased to advise that all three residents tested negative. In addition, the one (1) remaining staff member's results also returned negative.

All three residents remain asymptomatic and will remain on isolation in private rooms for the remainder of the 14 days. The four (4) asymptomatic staff remain at home on self-isolation for 14 days and must have two negative tests before returning to work.

We continue to monitor and test any resident and/or staff member with symptoms(s) consistent with COVID-19 and are working closely with Public Health Sudbury & Districts in determining next steps (i.e., further testing).

Although this is positive news, we remain vigilant and continue to implement further measures to protect residents and staff.
