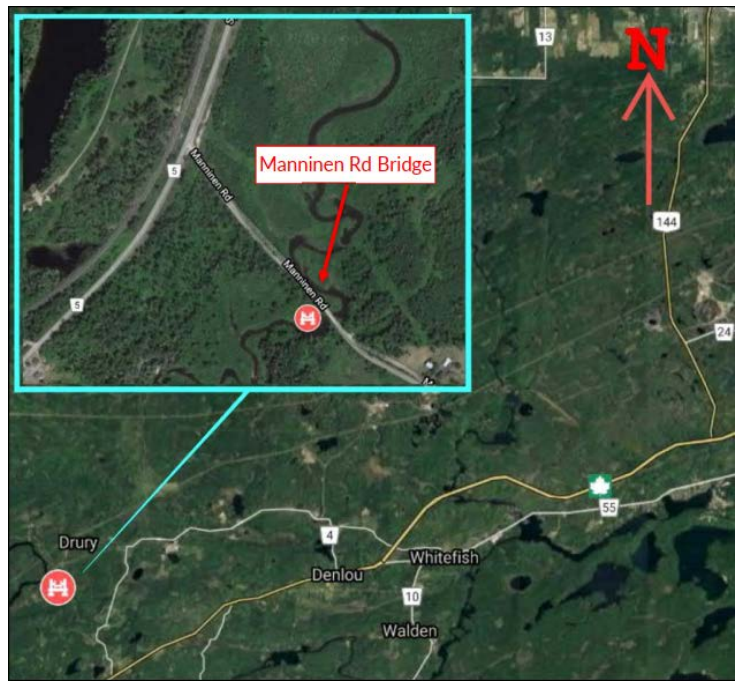

ENG21-51 Bridge Rehabilitation Manninen Road Bridge # 1003

The City of Greater Sudbury will be rehabilitating Manninen Rd Bridge span over a tributary of Spanish River, approximately **350m south of Spanish River Road**.

Construction Details:

- Replace existing timber decking and bridge barriers.
- Recoating steel girders.
- Detours will be provided to maintain local access, while Manninen Rd is closed.
- Installing new approach guardrail and end treatment system.
- Improved drainage by installing road drainage channels.
- Installing scour protection.
- Regrading bridge approaches.



Expected Start Date: Early Summer 2021

Expected End Date: End of Summer 2021

Timeline is subject to change

On March 24, 2020, the Province of Ontario classified the construction industry as essential. Work on the approved 2021 capital budget is ongoing and the City is committed to the planned infrastructure improvements.

Under normal circumstances, the City would hold public information sessions to explain these projects and their impact on communities. Instead, we are publishing information online and asking residents to review these documents from their homes.
