Kingsway Road, Sudbury Rehabilitation and Active Transportation Improvements

The City of Greater Sudbury will be completing **road improvements** on the **Kingsway**, from **Silver Hills Drive to Falconbridge Road**.

Construction Details:

- **Cycle infrastructure upgrades** (Introduction of “off road” cycle tracks)
- **Asphalt paving**
- **Urbanization of Kingsway between Barry Downe Road and Falconbridge Road** (new concrete sidewalk and curb on both sides of the roadway)
- **Watermain improvements**
- **Storm sewer improvements**
- **Lighting upgrades**
- **Traffic signal replacement**
- **Utility relocations**
- **AODA upgrades**

Expected Start Date: Summer 2022
Expected End Date: Fall 2023

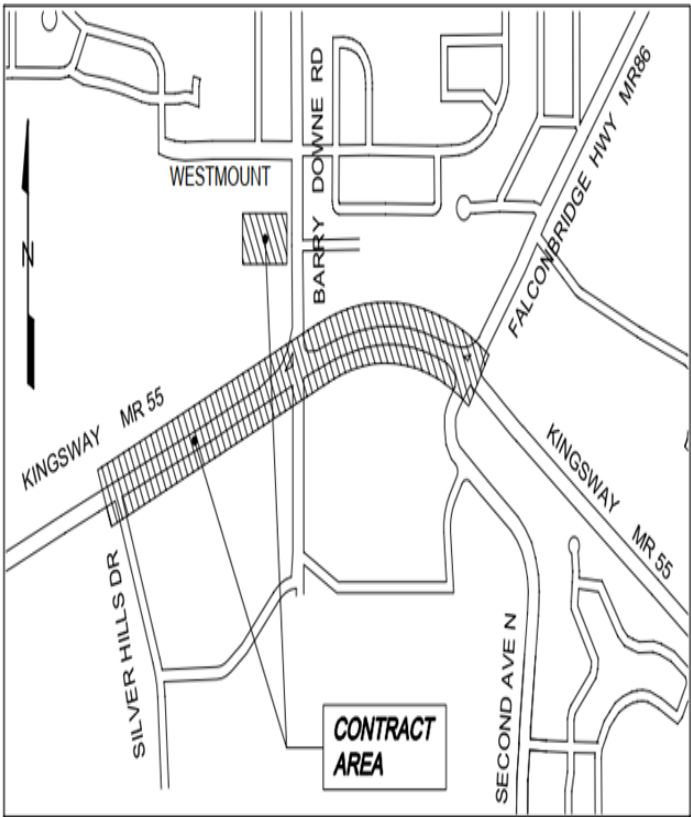
The construction phase of the Project is anticipated to be carried out between August 1, 2022 and October 31, 2023.


Phase 1 – Barry Downe Road to Falconbridge Road 2022 (surface asphalt to be placed in 2023)

Phase 2 – Silver Hills Drive to Barry Downe Road 2023)

Before Construction Begins:

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Once a Contractor has been selected, affected property owners will receive a construction notice with more information about the work.
- **The City is not responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on the municipal right-of-way.** Property owners should remove items located within the municipal right-of-way, such as landscaping, fencing, sprinkler systems and decorative objects.
- Once the Kingsway has been repaved with new asphalt, roadway cuts to install new utilities will not be permitted for a period of three years. Therefore, you should contact your hydro, gas, telephone or cable providers should you require changes to these services as well as notify the Project Manager and/or Contract Administrator listed below.
- Should you wish to make any modifications to your property entrance please contact the Project Manager listed below prior to July 15, 2022
- If blasting is required as part of the construction, you will be contacted regarding a pre-blast survey of your home to be completed prior to blasting operations commencing. The pre-blast survey is conducted by a third-party consultant and is a visual inspection of your home and other structures complete with photos and/or video. The consultant will be required to enter the home to complete the interior portion of the survey.
