## Paris Street, Sudbury - Bridge Rehabilitation

The City of Greater Sudbury will be completing road and bridge improvements on Paris Street between John Street and Van Horne Street.

Construction by the City's contractor, Belanger Construction Ltd., will be carried out between July 2022 and November 2022.

Work will take place Monday to Friday.


The work in 2022 will be primarily on the underside of the bridge, with deck surface and approach work planned for 2023.

Final asphalt planned to be completed in **October**, 2023.

Please note these timelines are subject to change.

## **Construction Details:**

- Installation of new bike lane on the bridge and approaches.
- Concrete removals and repair.
- Deck repairs, waterproofing and paving.
- Cleaning and coating girder ends.

	The City is not responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on the municipal right-of- way.
	Traffic:
H	Plans are in place to manage traffic in the area to ensure the safety of workers and residents. You may experience some delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.
T	Paris Street will be reduced to one lane of traffic in each direction to accommodate construction.

	If temporary driveway closures are required, the contractor will provide notice to the affected properties and make arrangements for alternative access and parking when necessary. <b>Entrances to businesses</b> <b>and public institutions shall remain accessible at all times.</b>
