The City of Greater Sudbury is planning road and water/wastewater improvements on David Street, between Paris Street and the west end and Marion Street between McNaughton Terrace and the north end, in Sudbury.

This project is part of the Council-approved Capital Project for Road and Water/Wastewater Improvements to fund roads for restoration to be completed in conjunction with water and wastewater projects. This project was selected by the road's asset management program and water/wastewater priorities.
