## Season Start-up Road Reconstruction, Watermain and Sewer Improvements Hyland Drive, Sudbury

The City of Greater Sudbury will continue the road and water/wastewater improvements on Hyland Drive, between Regent Street to Winchester Avenue, in Sudbury.

Construction by the City's Contractor, Garson Pipe Contractors Ltd. will begin **May 2023** and is expected to be completed by **October 2023**.

Work will typically take place during daylight hours Monday to Friday.

## **Construction Details:**

- Sidewalk installation on the south side of Hyland Drive from Wellington Heights to west of Killarney Avenue
- Surface asphalt from Wellington Heights to Winchester Avenue
- Landscaping and driveway restoration



During construction, there may be dust and noise in the area. The City makes every effort to reduce the impact to nearby residents and business owners. Thank you for your patience as we work to improve the roads and infrastructure in your neighbourhood. The City of Greater Sudbury and its contractors are committed to public safety and will monitor the ongoing progress of construction.

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## Traffic:

Plans are in place to manage traffic in the area to ensure the safety of workers and residents. You may experience some delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

At times, **Hyland Drive** may be reduced to one lane of traffic to accommodate construction.



## **Driveway Access:**

If temporary driveway closures are required, the contractor will provide notice to the affected properties and make arrangements for alternative access and parking when necessary.



## **Road and Sidewalk Access:**

Access for pedestrians will be maintained. Parents are reminded to teach children about road safety in active construction zone areas. Residents who have accessibility needs, such as wheelchair access, are asked to contact the City Field Inspector or Project Manager listed on this notice.



## **Emergency Services and Public Transit:**

Access for police, fire and paramedic services vehicles will be maintained at all times.

### Garbage Collection:

Garbage, recycling, and leaf and yard trimmings pickup will not be affected by construction. Please place your waste at the front of your property before 7 a.m. on your regular collection day. If waste collection vehicles are unable to access properties in the construction area, the contractor will transport the waste outside of the zone for pickup. Your garbage, recycling and organics containers will be returned to your property later in the day. Please ensure your containers are labeled with your address so that they can be returned to you.



## Mail Delivery:

Should the work affect mail delivery to your home, Canada Post will inform you of any changes to the scheduled route or provide you a location you can pick up your mail.



## **Property Restoration:**

Items located within the municipal right-of-way that are affected by construction will be restored with concrete, asphalt, sod and other landscaping features as required. Typically sod and landscaping will be completed during ideal growing seasons in the early spring or late fall. If you have specific concerns, please contact the City Field Inspector or Project Manager listed on this notice.

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
