Proposed Construction, Lansing Avenue, Sudbury

The City of Greater Sudbury is seeking feedback regarding the proposed construction project below.

The City of Greater Sudbury will be completing **culvert and road improvements** on **Lansing Avenue** over Junction Creek, north of Melbourne Street.

Project Highlights:

- Rehabilitation and cleaning of twin CSP culverts
- Two-way traffic will be maintained during construction
- Concrete Lining of culvert bottom
- Placing rip-rap in culvert inlet and outlet
- Sidewalk repairs
- Site restoration
- Repaving at culvert and approaches

Expected Start Date: Summer 2023


Expected End Date: Early Fall 2023

Before Construction Begins:

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Once a Contractor has been selected, affected property owners will receive a construction notice with more information about the work.
- **The City is not responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on the municipal right-of-way.** Property owners should remove items located within the municipal right-of-way, such as landscaping, fencing, sprinkler systems and decorative objects.
- Once Lansing Avenue has been repaved with new asphalt, roadway cuts to install new utilities will not be permitted for a period of three years. Therefore, you should contact your hydro, gas, telephone or cable providers should you require changes to these services as well as notify the Project Manager below.
- Should you wish to make any modifications to your property entrance or replace an existing culvert, please contact the Project Manager listed below prior to **May 1, 2023**.
