Larch Street Reconstruction Intersection at Larch/Durham Streets, Sudbury

The City of Greater Sudbury will be continuing road and water/wastewater improvements on Larch Street, between Elgin and Durham Streets, in Sudbury.

Construction by the City's Contractor, Teranorth Construction & Engineering Ltd., has been ongoing since May 2023 and is expected to be completed October 2023.

The proposed work will **close the intersection at Larch and Durham streets from August 21, 2023 until September 1, 2023**. Detours will be in place for vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Work will typically take place during daylight hours Monday to Friday. Weekend or night work may be required.
