Larch Street, Sudbury Road, Water & Sewer Improvements

The City of Greater Sudbury will be completing road, water and sewer improvements on Larch Street between Elgin Street and Lisgar Street.

Construction Details:

- Watermain Replacement
- Sanitary Sewer Replacement and/or Rehabilitation
- Storm and Drainage Improvements
- Active Transportation Improvements (2 through lanes reduced to 1 through lane and the introduction of an on street cycle lane)
- Full Depth Asphalt Removal
- Supply and Placement of Asphalt
- Concrete Curb Removal and Replacement (barrier curb to be replaced with a mountable curb to improve accessibility)
- Driveway/Entrance Restoration
- Above grade planters to be replaced with at grade trees.

Expected Start Date: Spring/Summer 2022

Expected End Date: Spring/Summer 2024

Construction will be phased over 2 years.

- Phase 1 – Durham Street to Lisgar Street (Surface Asphalt to be placed in 2023 for these limits)
- Phase 2 – Elgin Street to Durham Street (Surface Asphalt to be placed in 2024 for these limits)

Timeline is subject to change

Before Construction Begins:

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Once a Contractor has been selected, affected property owners will receive a construction notice with more information about the work.
- Property owners should remove items located within the municipal right-of-way, such as landscaping, fencing, sprinkler systems and decorative objects by May 31, 2022.
- Property owners should redirect to above ground, any roof drains and/or sump pump outlets that currently discharge into the front ditch.
- **The City is not responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on the municipal right-of-way.**
- Once Larch Street has been repaved with new asphalt, roadway cuts to install new utilities will not be permitted for a period of three years. Therefore, you should contact your hydro, gas, telephone or cable providers should you require changes to these services as well as notify the Project Manager listed below.
- Construction will reduce traffic to one lane between Durham Street and Lisgar Street in 2022. Intersections of Durham Street and Lisgar Street may also be reduced to one lane.
- Full road closure between Elgin Street to Durham Street in 2023. Elgin Street will be reduced to one lane.
- Should you wish to make any modifications to your property entrance or replace an existing culvert, please contact the Project Manager listed below prior to **May 31, 2022**.
