# Watermain Replacement and Pavement Rehabilitation Sparks Street, Sudbury

The City of Greater Sudbury is planning **road and water/wastewater improvements** on **Sparks Street, Sudbury** between **Roy Avenue** and **Barry Downe Road** in Sudbury.

This project is part of a Council-approved capital project to renew our aging infrastructure, improve water distribution and reduce the risk of watermain breaks.

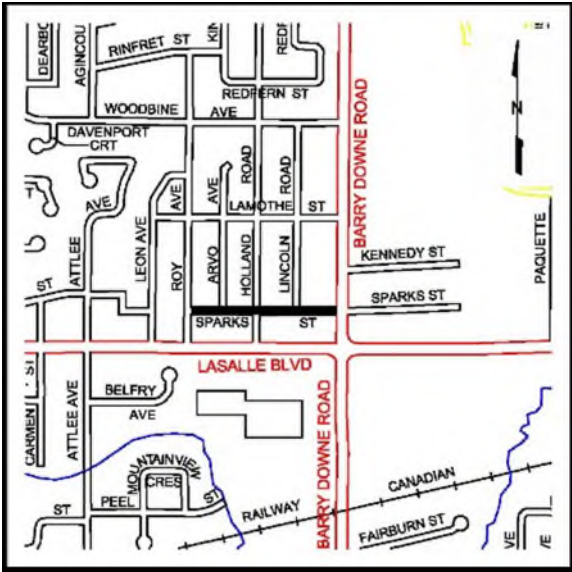
**Project Highlights:**

- Watermain replacement

- Traffic calming with the addition of speed humps
- Ditching and drainage improvements
- Surface asphalt to be placed in 2024

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**Before Construction Begins:**

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Once a contractor has been selected, affected property owners will receive a construction notice with more information about the work.
- A public consultation meeting will be held for this project. A notice will be sent to area residents once the date and location has been confirmed.
- Property owners should redirect to above ground, any roof drains and/or sump pump outlets that currently discharge into the front ditch.
- **The City is not responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on the municipal right-of-way.** Remove items such as landscaping, fencing, sprinkler systems and decorative objects.
- Once Sparks Street has been repaved with new asphalt, roadway cuts to install new utilities will not be permitted for a period of three years. Contact your hydro, gas, telephone or cable providers if you require changes to these services and notify the project manager.
- To make any modifications to your property entrance or replace an existing culvert, contact the project manager before June 5, 2023.
- If blasting is required, you will be contacted to complete a pre-blast survey of your home before blasting begins. It is conducted by a third-party consultant and is a visual inspection of your home and other structures complete with photos and/or video. The consultant must enter the home to complete the interior portion of the survey.
- The project manager will reach out if there are further impacts to your property.
