## Intersection Improvements Lasalle Boulevard at Frood Road, Sudbury

The City of Greater Sudbury will be completing the **construction of a roundabout at Lasalle Boulevard and Frood Road**, in Sudbury.

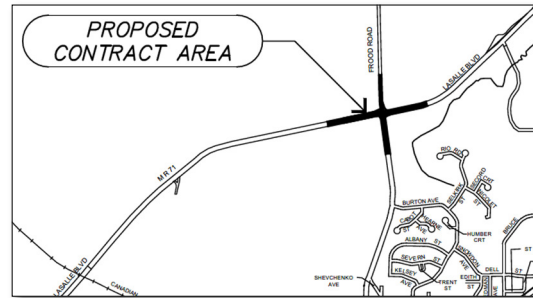
Construction by the City's Contractor, Teranorth Construction & Engineering Limited, **will begin June 2023 and is expected to be completed by November 2023.**

This project is part of the Council-approved Capital Project for Arterial/Collector Roads Rehabilitation and Resurfacing program. The two-lane roundabout is recommended in the Transportation Master Plan and removes an area of congestion from the Maley Drive/LaSalle Boulevard corridor and **completes Phase 1 of the Maley Drive Extension project.**

Work will typically take place during daylight hours, Monday to Friday.

### Project Highlights:

- Reconfiguration of the existing intersection at Lasalle Blvd and Frood Rd to introduce a two-lane roundabout.
- Installation of new streetlights at the roundabout



During construction, there may be dust and noise in the area. The City makes every effort to reduce the impact to nearby residents and business owners. Thank you for your patience as we work to improve the roads and infrastructure in your neighbourhood. The City of Greater Sudbury and its contractors are committed to public safety and will monitor the ongoing progress of construction.

	<p><b>Before Construction Begins:</b> Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities. Once the roundabout and associated lanes have been repaved with new asphalt, roadway cuts to install new utilities will not be permitted for a period of three years. Therefore, you should contact your hydro, gas, telephone or cable providers should you require changes to these services as well as notify the Project Manager.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic:</b> Plans are in place to manage traffic in the area to ensure the safety of workers and residents. You may experience some delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction to accommodate construction. <b>A full road closure on Frood Rd will occur from July 2023 to September 2023.</b> The roads will remain open to emergency vehicles at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Emergency Services and Public Transit:</b> Access for police, fire and paramedic services vehicles will be maintained at all times. Public transit detours may occur during construction. Should the work affect the school bus route, the Sudbury Student Services Consortium will inform you of any changes to the scheduled route.</p>
