

Hyland Drive and Wellington Heights, Sudbury Road Reconstruction, Watermain and Sewer Improvements

The City of Greater Sudbury will be completing road and water/wastewater improvements on Hyland Drive from Regent Street to Winchester Avenue and Wellington Heights from Hyland Drive to the cul-de-sac in Sudbury.

Construction Details:

- Addition of bike lanes and asphalt boulevard on Hyland Drive from Regent Street to Connaught Avenue.
- Reconstruction of roadway with installation of new asphalt, concrete curbs at both locations.
- Installation of sidewalk on both sides of Hyland Drive.
- Removal of sidewalk on south side of Wellington Heights installation of sidewalk and asphalt boulevard on the north side Wellington Heights.
- Installation of new watermain including water services from the watermain to the property line at both locations.
- Installation of new sanitary sewer including sanitary sewer services from the sanitary sewer main to the property line at both locations.
- Replacement of some storm sewer.

Before Construction Begins:

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Soils Investigation to determine sub-soil surface conditions. This work is expected to take place prior to Construction.
- Once a Contractor has been selected, affected property owners will receive a construction notice with more information about the work.
- Property owners should redirect to above ground, any roof drains and/or sump pump outlets that currently discharge into the front ditch.
- The City is not responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on the municipal right-ofway. Property owners should remove items located within the municipal right-of-way, such as landscaping, fencing, sprinkler systems and decorative objects.
- Once your street has been repaved with new asphalt, roadway cuts to install new utilities will not be
 permitted for a period of three years. Therefore, you should contact your hydro, gas, telephone or
 cable providers should you require changes to these services as well as notify the Project Manager
 below.
