# ENG21-61 Bridge Replacement Nelson Lake Road Bridge #3000

The City of Greater Sudbury will be replacing **Nelson Lake Road Bridge** over Rapid River, approximately **500 m West of Desmarais Road.** 

Construction by the City's contractor, Belanger Construction Ltd., will be carried out between June 2021 and October 2021.

Work will take place

Monday to Friday,

7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Final road surface will be completed on **October** 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Please note these timelines are subject to change.

# **Construction Details:**

- Replacing existing bridge with a single lane concrete slab-on-girder bridge;
- Constructing temporary single lane detour bridge to maintain traffic;
- Installing new guiderails and energy attenuating end treatments;
- Improved drainage by installing road drainage channels and ditching;
- Installing scour protection;
- Regrading and paving bridge approaches.



During construction, there may be dust and noise in the area. The City makes every effort to reduce the impact to nearby residents and business owners. Thank you for your patience as we work to improve the roads and infrastructure in your neighbourhood. The City of Greater Sudbury and its contractors are committed to public safety and will monitor the ongoing progress of construction.
