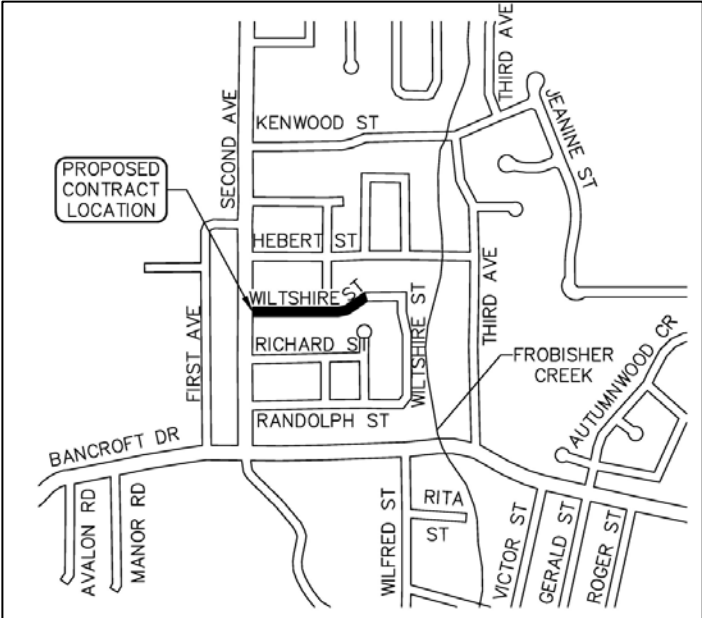
Wiltshire Street, Sudbury

Road Reconstruction & Watermain Replacement

The City of Greater Sudbury will be completing **road and water improvements** on **Wiltshire Street, Sudbury**, between Second Avenue and 70m East of Adams Street.

What we’re proposing:


- Installation of new concrete sidewalk and sod boulevard on the North side from Second Avenue to Adam Street
- Installation of new concrete curb on both sides of the road
- Fill in ditches and install a new storm system within roadway
- Road reconstruction with new granulars and asphalt
- Installation of a new watermain with services to property line



Expected Start Date: Spring 2022

Expected End Date: Summer 2023

Before Construction Begins:

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- Once a Contractor has been selected, affected property owners will receive a construction notice with more information about the work.
- Property owners should redirect to above ground, any roof drains and/or sump pump outlets that currently discharge into the front ditch.
- **The City is not responsible for damage to any privately-owned items on the municipal right-of-way.** Property owners should remove items located within the municipal right-of-way, such as landscaping, fencing, sprinkler systems and decorative objects.
- Once Wiltshire has been repaved with new asphalt, roadway cuts to install new utilities will not be permitted for a period of three years. Therefore, you should contact your hydro, gas, telephone or cable providers should you require changes to these services as well as notify the Project Manager below.
- Should you wish to make any modifications to your property entrance please contact the Project Manager listed below prior to May 13, 2022.
- We have also camera inspected your sanitary sewer service and plan to replace your service from the sewer main to lot line.
