Minimum MANDATORY Requirements for Volunteer Firefighters:

- Completion of Grade 12 Education or Certified Trade Certificate
- Possess a valid Class "G" Driver's License
- Must possess or have access to own transportation
- Standard First Aid Certificate and Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Level C
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Maintain physical fitness for Firefighter requirements
- Must live in the coverage area of a volunteer station

Please note: applicants are asked to list their certificates or transcripts on the application form but not include them. Proof will be requested at the interview stage.
