Strategic Plan Development Process

The Early Years Planning Network represents 19 Sudbury-based not-for-profit licensed child care providers, school boards, public health, and childhood specialty organizations. The network is a planning, coordination and collaboration body that supports early years system integration.

Between October 22, 2022 - March 2023, the network convened to develop a strategic direction to focus its efforts over the next five years. The resultant Early Years Planning Network Strategic Plan 2024-29 is still being refined.






